- The NTI Trade Show has moved to the University of Michigan Indoor Training Center for a ONE AND A HALF DAY show, Saturday and Sunday.
 - The Trade Show will open on Saturday, July 25, with Registration/Check-in opening at 9:00 a.m. and the Trade Show opening at 10:00 a.m. Both will run until 5:00 p.m.
 - The Trade Show will reopen Sunday, July 26, with Registration/Check-in opening at 8:00 a.m. and the Trade Show opening at 8:30 a.m. Both will close at Noon.
