

Outstanding Apprentice Graduates Attending NTI 2026

We are pleased to announce that the Outstanding Apprentice Graduates will commence their NTI 2026 experience with a carefully curated schedule designed to support both professional development and engagement. Please review the following details regarding key events and expectations.

All graduates are required to begin the NTI program at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, July 26, at the George Gervin GameAbove Center (G3) at Eastern Michigan University, which serves as the location for the trade show. Upon arrival, please follow the directional signs in the atrium to the Auxiliary Gym on the lower level, where attendance will be recorded. Graduates will then participate in exclusive demonstrations presented by our Award-Winning Training Partners on the trade show floor.

Lunch will be provided in the Auxiliary Gym from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m., followed by a recognition ceremony during which representatives from our Award-Winning Training Partners will present a commemorative gift to each graduate in honor of their achievements. Afterward, graduates will attend an orientation session, including introductions and a comprehensive overview of the week's program with their instructors. The day's activities are scheduled to conclude at approximately 2:30 p.m., allowing adequate time for graduates to return to their accommodations and prepare for the Opening Ceremony scheduled for later that day. Transportation to and from the G3 Center is the responsibility of each attendee.

The Opening Ceremony, celebrating the exceptional accomplishments of the Outstanding Apprentice Graduates, will take place Sunday evening at the G3 Center. Graduates are requested to assemble in the Auxiliary Gym no later than 4:45 p.m. for a group photograph prior to the start of the ceremony.

As part of the Opening Ceremony, all outstanding apprentice graduates are required to follow the event dress code. Participants will be provided with a black polo shirt to wear during the ceremony. You will receive this shirt when you pick up your registration packet at the trade show. The polo shirt should be paired with professional business attire, such as slacks, skirts, and professional footwear.

Casual items such as ball caps, sunglasses, tennis shoes, sandals, and flip-flops are not permitted. Participants who do not meet the dress code requirements may not be permitted to take part in the Opening Ceremony.
